1. Kenya Case Study: Multiple Shocks and Stresses

The global shock of COVID-19 led to a lockdown in early 2020, with a cessation of transport and logistics, school closures, disrupting supplies of medicines, food, and non-food items into Northern Kenya. During the same period, Kenya experienced an invasion of desert locusts in these areas, the worst in 70 years. The desert locusts and pandemic continued to be issues in the region, exacerbating vulnerability and forcing families into poverty. A Rift Valley Fever disease outbreak also lead to massive abortions of livestock and death of pastoralists. Drought resulted in acute water and pasture shortages, causing internal and cross-border migration that has led to an increase in violent conflict. The situation was compounded by insecurity and resource-based conflict in some areas.

In response, your organization Resilience Partner, is going to work directly with national and county governments to expand upon an existing drought management system built up over a decade of partnership. This type of planning, coordinating, and financing through a disaster risk management approach can significantly improve the speed and effectiveness of responses when a disaster strikes. As such, your strategy is expected to take a multi-sectoral approach, layering, sequencing, and integrating various funding streams and technical sectors, including agriculture; biodiversity; water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH).
