4. Analyse the perceptions of Dambisa Moyo on the economic implications of China's ascendancy as the lead buyer of the world's resources.
5. Assess the view that Structural Adjustment Programmes (SAPS) were "an imperial design to open a country's resources to unregulated pillage" (Petras, 1997:5).
