community and international financial organisation for aid to resuscitate the country's

infrastructure. Supranational bodies and donor agencies such as the Bretton Woods

institutions, USAID, DANIDA and the African Development Bank have pledged U\$1 billion

towards resuscitating Kavangoland's infrastructure. Dominique Auriacombe a recent

Engineering graduate has been appointed project engineer for the road resuscitation project.

He has been tasked with resuscitating Kavangoland's 10 000-kilometre road network which

was almost entirely destroyed by the war. Unfortunately, Dominique does not have any

project management experience. You are hired as a consultant to guide Dominique

throughout the entire process.

Required:

a. Advise Dominique on how he is supposed to conduct himself from the beginning till the

end of the project.

b. Explain to Dominique the project management techniques that are likely to be useful to

him.
