Required:

Explain the essential elements of a valid contract and Jane's prospect of success in the suit. [20 marks]

Question 4

Kembo wants to buy the tyre fitment centre owned by his arch-rival Jacob. He is convinced that Jacob would never sell to him out of spite so he appoints Tendai as his agent with the specific instruction that Tendai must not disclose to Jacob that he is acting as an agent. Tendai successfully negotiates a purchase agreement and then drops the bombshell on Jacob that he was in fact acting as Kembo's agent.

Required:

Fully explain this type of arrangement under the law of agency.
